- ¹ ALWAYS water test sprayer before each use.
- ¹ ALWAYS wear long sleeve shirts, long pants, goggles, gloves and durable shoes.
- ¹ ALWAYS read and follow label instructions for the chemicals to be applied.
- ¹ AFTER USE release pressure and clean the sprayer after each use.
- ALWAYS release pressure in sprayer before servicing.

- ¹ DO NOT alter any components on the sprayer.
- ¹ DO NOT spray flammable, caustic (i.e. acids, chlorines), corrosive or self-heating solutions with the sprayers.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

1. Remove the loose parts from inside the tank.

2. To properly attach the agitator to the pump, slide it on the hex shaped area and rotate it to lock in place.



3. When installed, it should be perpendicular to the hose outlet.



4. Place the strainer into the tank opening and screw the lid on.

To ensure a good seal, turn lid counterclockwise until it lines up with the threads. Then turn clockwise to tighten down.



Place the pumping lever on the lever shaft, securing it with the pin.



6. Assemble the spray wand into the shut-off and tighten manually.



7. Assemble the nozzle onto the spray wand.



MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

- After use, the sprayer should be properly cleaned and stored away from direct sunlight to prevent UV damage.
- After removing the piston or mounting a new collar, treat both the collar and the piston with a petroleum jelly.
- Before storing for the winter, be sure that all liquid is completely drained from the tank, lines and air chamber.
- Leave flow control locked on when storing.
- Regularly inspect hose, wand, pump, tank and flow control for wear, damage or leaks.
- Avoid excessive wear by regular lubrication and a prompt and thorough cleaning after each use.

DISASSEMBLY AND CLEANING

- 1. Place the sprayer upright on a flat surface.
- 2. Remove rod connected to the pump.



3. Loosen the guide nut of the tank. Pull the pump tube out. To inspect the seal at the bottom of the pump, remove the piston holder and make sure the seal is clean and in good condition.





4. To remove the piston ring, unscrew the guide, nut, change the ring, and tighten again.



- ¹ After each use, clean the tank thoroughly. If some solution remains, dispose of properly and drain tank completely.
- ¹ Follow recommendations of chemical manufacturer for proper disposal of any remaining spray solution.
- ¹ Pumping causes air to be taken in and the remaining liquid to be discharged. Pump until most of the liquid and air are completely discharged through the nozzle.
- Refill the tank with a few quarts of soap water (a mild dish detergent is recommended) and discharge through the nozzle. If necessary, repeat this procedure several times to ensure that the sprayer is clean.
- If the flow control is removed, the pump can quickly be flushed.
- ¹Sporadic spray distribution is caused by a clogged nozzle. If necessary, remove and clean nozzle.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Always depressurize the sprayer, remove all chemical solution and clean the sprayer before making repairs. Replacement parts can be ordered by calling our Customer Service Hotline at 1-800-9-SPRAYER.

Problem	Solution	
1. The piston does not slide smoothly and requires more effort.	Lubricate the piston and the seal with petroleum jelly.	
2. When pumping the sprayer, no pressure is building up.	Check the piston seal and make sure it's generously lubricated. If it's damaged, a new one must be purchased. (Recommended lubrication is petroleum jelly)	
3. Shut-off sticks or is hard to use.	Lubricate all seals, replace if necessary. (Recommended lubrication is petroleum jelly)	
4. Liquid leaks between the flow control and the wand.	Make sure the nut is tightened down, replace seals if necessary.	~
